

Pumpkin Treat Bag

The {Stamps} of Life
Thanks2Fall Stamp Set



Supplies:

3" x 5" white unlined index card
orange, green, and black stamp pads
black gingham ribbon, 6-8"
long-reach rectangle punch
4.5" x 3" zip closure bag
Fall-themed candy (candy corn, candy pumpkins, chocolates wrapped in fall colors)
Sponge
Adhesive
3-D foam adhesive square
Tall, skinny pumpkin stamp
The {Stamps} of Life Stamps:
Outline for tall skinny pumpkin stamp
Solid stem stamp
Solid leaf stamp
Outline for solid leaf stamp
Acrylic block

1. Cut white cardstock to 3" x 5" or use an unlined index card. Fold in the middle at 2.5" for card base.
2. Using a sponge, dab orange ink around the edges of the front of the card.
3. On another sheet of cardstock, stamp the tall, skinny pumpkin three times in orange. The lighter pumpkins are a second-generation stamping (i.e. the second time the stamp was applied to the paper without re-inking it). Add the black outlining and the stem to each pumpkin. Re-ink the outline stamp in black each time.
4. Stamp the leaves in green (one first-generation stamp, two second-generation stamps for lighter colors) and leaf outline on another sheet of cardstock.
5. Cut out the pumpkins and leaves, glue the leaves to the pumpkins.
6. Adhere the lighter pumpkins directly to the card base. The fold should be at the top of the card.
7. Using a 3-D foam adhesive, attach the darker pumpkin to the middle of the card.
8. Cut ribbon holes in the card bottom and the top of 4.5" x 3" zip closure bag using a long-reach rectangle punch.
9. Fill treat bag with fall candy.

10. Thread 6" ribbon through ribbon holes and tie a knot.
